**MERGER**: The Classic HOA met recently to review options about the proposed merging of our two HOAs. Unanimous support for the merger was expressed by the 25 of us present. The attorney handling our business is working on the draft of a combined set of covenants which should be ready this summer. The plan is to circulate the revised covenants to all Classic owners with a ballot. A two thirds majority is required to complete the transaction. Highlands owners don't have to do anything as Classic would be merged into Highlands. Dues for Classic owners would go up to \$165/year; dues for Highlands owners would go down to \$165. The target date for completing the merger is January 1, 2004.

The advantages of having a single HOA are many, but in simple terms, we simplify our operation, e.g., one bank account, one board, one set of books, etc. We unify by coming together ..... a single set of covenants, we become a more significant body of owners = more clout, we create a much more sizable budget and we create loyalty to one organization versus being split. It will be easier to manage and we can accomplish more.

**NOXIOUS WEEDS**: Be reminded that you are responsible for making sure your lot is clear of noxious weeds. The HOA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MOW YOUR LOT AT YOUR EXPENSE IF YOU DON'T.

**FIREWISE:** Conditions are dry even though we've had some good rains. Please be attentive to these suggestions for protecting your property .....

- Thin trees and shrubs within 70 feet from your house
- Roof and gutters clear of pine needles and leaves
- Remove branches overhanging the roof and chimney
- Prune trees to 10 feet off the ground
- Firewood piles 30 feet from house
- Make sure house number can be easily seen from street night and day

**NEPCO:** This acronym stands for Northern El Paso County Coalition of Community Associations. Our HOAs are members. NEPCO represents homeowners in our area primarily to the county on matters relating to development and/or expansion. NEPCO recently responded to the Wal-Mart issue by recommending disapproval of their rezoning request and suggested the store be located in an appropriately zoned site. Concerns were expressed about the traffic, water consumption and drainage.
